

HAMPSHIRE HOGS v WILTSHIRE QUERIES

Hampshire Hogs proved obliging guests in Devizes after being invited across the county border to help mark the 75th anniversary of the Wiltshire Queries. The home side totalled 255 for eight declared after winning the toss, with Mark Low taking 3-69 and Chris Southwell also making inroads with the ball, before the Hogs were undone by some high-class left-arm swing bowling and a pitch taking increasing turn. At one stage they slumped to 54 for seven but the tail wagged defiantly and delayed the inevitable until midway through the final 20 overs. The visiting side were finally bowled out for 103 and lost by 152 runs, one of the more lop-sided margins in the history of a keenly-contested fixture which dates back to the mid 1930s.
